Welcome to GCSE French!

Over the course of the next 2 years you will be studying various aspects of the French language and culture through a range of topics, many of which you will already have touched upon at KS3:

As usual, we will be practising the four main skills of language learning; speaking, listening, reading and writing in preparation for the GCSE exams - you will have one exam for each skill and each paper is worth 25% of the GCSE. Your teacher will explain the course structure in more detail in September.

In preparation for Year 10, vocabulary will be the most important area to focus on. Your "carnets de vocabulaire" from Year 7, 8 and 9 will be useful again! The MFL department aims to set up an account on a language learning platform for each GCSE class with key words to practise and revise ready for September.

Any exposure to the French language is beneficial! If you have the opportunity to watch any French films over the summer (with English subtitles) this would be a great idea - Netflix, Amazon Prime and other streaming platforms offer several different options. Alternatively, you could watch an English speaking film that you know with French audio or French subtitles.

This year we enjoyed a very successful trip to Paris with Year 10 and 11 students who not only benefited from practising their French in real life situations but also had the opportunity to visit all the famous landmarks. We hope to offer a similar trip in 2027.
