Upholding the Behaviour Policy - Detentions

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to emphasise the importance of our behaviour policy and the expectations we have for our students. Thank you for all your continued support.

I just wanted to take the opportunity to remind you that, by enrolling your child at our school, you are agreeing to support and uphold the behaviour policy we have in place. This policy is designed to ensure a safe and productive learning environment for all our students.

One key aspect of this policy is the use of detentions. If your child is set an afterschool detention, we expect them to attend unless there are extreme extenuating circumstances. Failure to attend an afterschool detention without a valid reason will result in further disciplinary action.

We understand that life can be unpredictable, and there may be rare occasions where your child is unable to attend an afterschool detention. In such cases, we ask that you communicate with the school in advance and make alternative arrangements.
