What inspired you to become a teacher/chaplin?

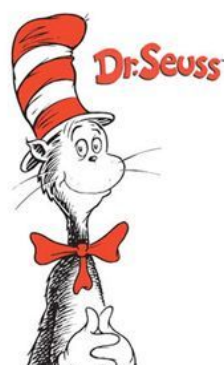
Mrs Bryant said that she enjoys working with young people and seeing their techniques. She also felt as if God was calling her to be a teacher and chaplain, she was called to the job.
