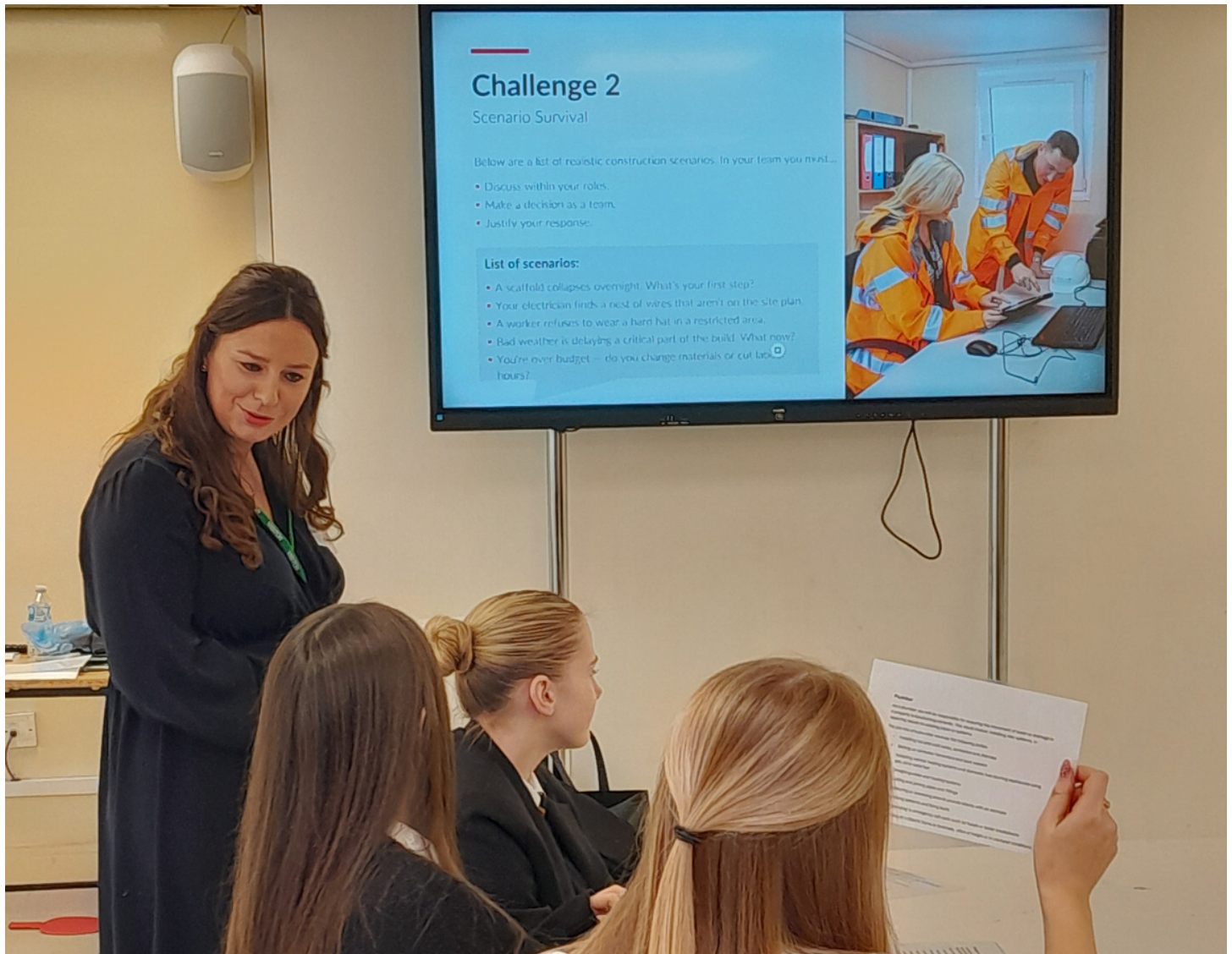

SKILLED TRADE EVENT-27th April

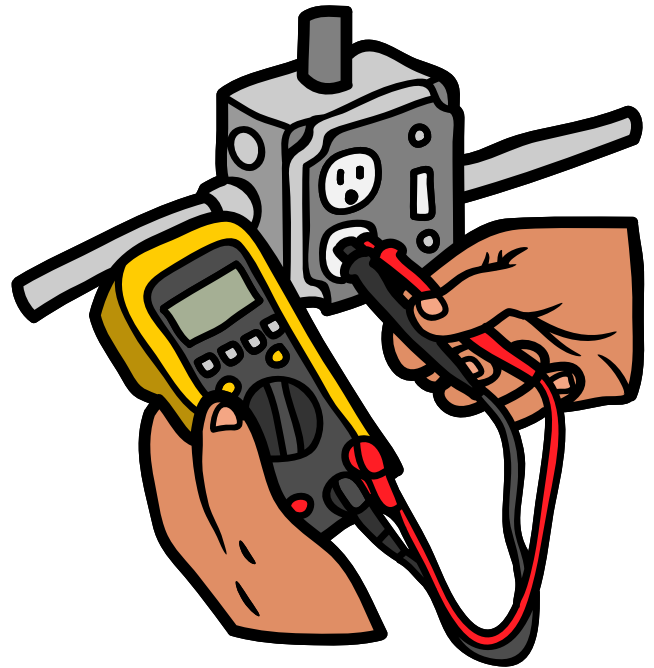
